No ceramic/glassware

No gift wrap, tissue
paper or carbon paper

No hazardous waste

Under the program, each eligible household will be provided with a blue 360L wheeled recycle tip cart.

Residents will place all of their accepted recycling material in the cart **loose** and **unsorted**. The material will be collected once a month in lieu of waste collection by your usual waste collection contractor.

WHAT GOES IN THE CART?

CARBOARD, BOXBOARD

Shipping boxes, cereal boxes, cracker boxes etc.

PLASTICS

Any item stamped with the number 1, 2, 4, 5.

(laundry detergent bottles, condiment bottles, shampoo & conditioner bottles, yogurt & sour cream containers, plastic milk jugs, berry containers etc.)

METAL CANS

All metal cans that a magnet will stick to (soup, fruit, and vegetable cans, apple juice cans, coffee tins and beverage cans).

PAPER

Newspapers, magazines, office paper, and books with the covers removed.

NOT SURE IF YOUR ITEM IS RECYCLABLE?

Check the WVRSC website, refer to the information booklet, or the app.
