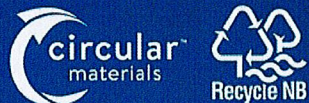


# District of Tobique Valley Recycling guide



## Accepted materials

Here's a quick summary of some of the materials that you can recycle!



**Cardboard:** Cereal boxes, egg cartons, corrugated cardboard, paper towel rolls.



**Papers:** Envelopes, newsprint paper.



**Metal:** Food and beverage cans, aerosol containers



**Plastic:** Containers, bottles, cans.



The District of Tobique Valley's recycling program is now managed by Circular Materials, a national not-for-profit organization that is committed to building an efficient and effective recycling system in New Brunswick.

There is no change to the materials you currently recycle or your recycling schedule.

## Recycling tips:

- Sort recyclable materials from garbage and organics.
- Flatten and bundle cardboard.
- Empty and give containers a quick rinse.
- Keep materials loose.
